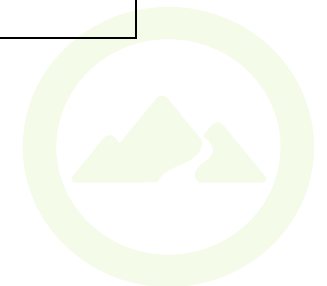

There are many other dining options within four miles of the downtown area; everything from an IHOP to The Prairie Schooner, (an upscale restaurant where you dine in a booth designed to look like a Conestoga Wagon in the midst of a camp scene. Specialties are steak, prime rib, and fresh seafood.)

Ogden, Utah, provides many fun and affordable attractions designed to meet the varied interests of visitors to our area. Your members will enjoy the following attractions: Union Station located on Historic 25th Street houses the following museums: The Utah Railroad Museum, Antique Car Museum, Natural History Museum, Model Railroad Museum, Art Gallery, Gift Shop, and the Browning Gun Museum, (the Browning family is from the Ogden area and chose this location to house their great historical display of the gun.) Here are more attractions your group can enjoy: Peery's Egyptian Theater (adjacent to the Ogden Eccles Conference Center,) is a restored Egyptian-themed theater that, among other events, is a Sundance screening venue; Hill Aerospace Museum, an amazing collection of military aircraft and missiles; and Hardware Ranch, an elk wildlife management refuge.

Now open, Ogden boasts the most unique high adventure center in the country. The Salomon Center, located in downtown Ogden, has something for everyone! The 125,000 square foot building encompasses an arcade, 32-lane bowling alley, billiard room, glow-in-the-dark miniature golf, bumper cars, Costa Vida Fresh Mexican Grill, The Pizza Factory, and Striker's Grill. For an additional fee, delegates can try their hand at I Fly Utah, a vertical wind tunnel that will simulate free-fall skydiving, or the Flowrider surf pool.
